The medical center has training programs for medical and pharmacy residents and participates in the training of pharmacy technicians, medical students, pharmacy students and nursing students. The inpatient pharmacy is decentralized with six satellite pharmacies and offers the full range of inpatient services. Our pharmacists are a highly respected member of the health care team.

The Los Angeles Medical Center is composed of the hospital, the surrounding clinics and outpatient pharmacies, the ambulatory care division, the home health division, and nuclear medicine division.
